Registration

Will be held on Thursday, Sept. 2, 2004, at the Intermediate School basement from 4 to 7 p.m. There is a \$5 registration fee per student, unless you pre-registered at recital last year.

Class Schedule

The dance year consists of three 9 week terms. Classes will be held once a week on Monday and Thursday evenings.

Private classes will be available on Monday night only. Student must also be enrolled in a class of the same subject.

1st Term: September 9—Nov. 11
2nd Term: Nov. 15—Feb. 3
3rd Term: February 7—April 14

Visitors are welcome to observe classes
The first week of each term.

Class Information

A class will consist of at least 5, but not more than 12 students. Ages are as follows:

Pre-BalletAges 3-5
BalletAges 6 & up
TapAges 5 & up
JazzAges 7 & up

Dress Code: leotard, pink tights, pink ballet shoes for ballet. Black jazz shoes for jazz class. Black tap shoes for tap class.

Tuition

\$75 for each 1/2 hour class per term.
\$100 for each 45 minute class per term.

Tuition for each 9-week term must be paid by the first day of each term. 5% discount if year is paid in full at registration. No refunds on full-year payments.

There will be no refunds for classes missed, except with a medical excuse.

There will be a \$20 penalty charge for any check returned to the studio.

Shannon McCann has danced since she was 4 years old. She has been a teacher at both the main studio and in Belleville the past five years. Shannon studies dance at CNADM and DMW conventions. She has performed at Disney World, as well as many local events and competitions.

Heather McCann has danced since she was 3 years old. She has been a demonstrator at the main studio for 5 years. She was our substitute teacher in Madison and Belleville last year. Miss Heather continues her own dance education through conventions and advanced classes in Ballet, Jazz, and Tap.
